

FOR COOL FAMILIES: ADVENTURES BETWEEN GLACIER, MOUNTAIN, AND LAKE

Race against each other on slides in the ICE ARENA on the Kitzsteinhorn, enjoy Schmidolin's adventures on the Schmittenhöhe panorama and family mountain, three lidos on Lake Zell and a cool family activity programme. With this - and much more, Zell am See-Kaprun attracts all active families with children to SalzburgerLand. In this oversized children's (and adults') playground, the fantastic three await: glacier, mountain. and lake! Here are six children's surprises for 2024 in the Zell am See-Kaprun region of adventures and experiences:

CHILDREN'S SURPRISE 1: WELCOME TO THE FAMILY MOUNTAIN

The Schmittenhöhe panorama and family mountain is the realm of a little dragon called "Schmidolin". Whether on the "Schmidolin's Baptism of Fire" adventure trail, in the "Schmidolin's Blazing Wheels" e-motocross park and in the "Offroad Park", plenty of nature and action-packed experiences await adventurers of all ages. Schmidolin demands and encourages balance, cleverness, and courage. This makes hiking a real experience for the whole family. By the way: from summer 2024, there will be a viewing platform at the upper terminus, inviting you to share unforgettable moments on social media and inspiring teenagers to come on hiking tours too. And for older, growing, and grown-up children, the Schmitten Children's Festival will be back in 2024.

CHILDREN'S SURPRISE 2: DOWNHILL FUN ON THE "MAISI FLITZER"

The Maiskogel is the ideal excursion destination for families. The upper terminus of the MK Maiskogelbahn cable car is the starting point for the "Maiskogel Hüttenrunde" hut tour. The circular route for families is in most parts suitable for pushchairs and leads past four mountain huts. The Alpine Coaster called "Maisi Flitzer" is located right in the centre of Kaprun and offers fast-paced summer tobogganing fun for the whole family.

CHILDREN'S SURPRISE 3: SNOW AND TOBOGGANING IN SUMMER?

That's only possible in the ICE ARENA on the Kitzsteinhorn! You can get to the glacier experience by using the ultra-modern K-ONNECTION from the centre of Kaprun. At 3,029 metres above sea level, it's worth making a detour to the "TOP OF SALZBURG" panorama platform for the ultimate selfie with a backdrop of three-thousand-metre-high peaks. Event tip: The chefs of tomorrow will be skilfully wielding their wooden spoons at the "Cool Kids Cook Maiskogel" on 31 May 2024.

CHILDREN'S SURPRISE 4: PLENTY OF WATER IN AND ON LAKE ZELL

Kids just love water! Especially when it's crystal clear and around 23 degrees warm. Just like Lake Zell. In summer, it is the undisputed favourite with locals and visitors alike. Three lidos on the lakeshore invite you to enjoy a relaxing day of aqua fun. Here you will find shaded spots on the sunbathing lawn, playgrounds, heated pools - some with slides, and plenty of



opportunities to let off steam in and on the water. And if the little ones are happy, so are the parents.

CHILDREN'S SURPRISE 5: WEEKLY PROGRAMME FULL OF VARIETY

Zell am See-Kaprun welcomes families with children and offers a weekly programme, plus a children's programme in summer. And both programmes have a lot to offer. The activities for guests range from a hike by torchlight through the mystical Sigmund Thun Gorge on the "Legendary Night of the Water" to Ilama trekking tours, and from sunrise hikes, mountain yoga and an action tyre ride on Lake Zell to the "Kitzsteinhorn Explorer Tour" with a national park ranger through four climate zones.

CHILDREN'S SURPRISE 6: SUSTAINABLE HOLIDAYS IN ZELL AM SEE-KAPRUN

Less of a surprise for the kids than for the parents: holidays in Zell am See-Kaprun go hand in hand with respect for the environment. Thanks to rail co-operations, you can travel clean and environmentally friendly by train. With the "Pinzgau Mobility Card", you can travel by public transport, and with the Zell am See-Kaprun Summer Card you can also use lifts and the excursion boat. The high mountain reservoirs supply the region with clean electricity from hydropower, and the cable cars run on 100 per cent renewable energy. In other words, a clean and green holiday!
