- Eventful hiking days: over 400 kilometres of marked trails, for example on the Schmittenhöhe - the family and panorama mountain - or on the Maiskogel in Kaprun
- Endless MTB possibilities: 240 kilometres of cycle and bike trails as well as four high alpine single trails between Kitzsteinhorn and Kparun
- Longing for fun on and in the lake: Lake Zell, with temperatures up to 23 degrees and an excellent quality of water, offers refreshment for every water sports enthusiast
- 36-hole Leading Golf Course: one of the most beautiful greens in the Alps
- Gravel Biking: on five designated gravel bike routes throughout the region
- Trail running: out and about on trails with great views, such as the 'Hochsonnbergalm Trail'
