HOLIDAYS BETWEEN GLACIER, MOUNTAIN AND LAKE - THE EXCURSION AND TOP TIPS FOR SUMMER 2022:

- The **Kaprun High Mountain Reservoirs** are a monumental excursion destination of superlatives: the structure with two mighty dam walls in the midst of a magnificent, high alpine mountain backdrop is a "wonder world of technology". An excursion to an altitude of over 2,000 metres above sea level also provides an insight into state-of-the-art electricity generation with the help of hydroelectric power. The dimensions of the dam walls are gigantic: The "Moosersperre" dam is 107 metres high and 494 metres long. The visitor centre "Electricity and Ice Adventure World" is open daily during the summer months, admission is free. A guided tour of the dam wall offers fascinating insights into the man-made structure. Here you will also find

the world's highest-situated via ferrata on a dam wall as well as the "Höhenburg Climbing Arena" with further vie ferrate and sport climbing facilities.

- On its way from the mountain to the valley, the Kapruner Ache river roars through the rocky and mystical **Sigmund Thun Gorge**: this is a refreshing nature and hiking experience for the whole family. Once you have hiked through the gorge on well-secured boardwalks, you reach the Klammsee lake. The Sigmund Thun Gorge is open from May to October. On selected dates, mystical evening tours take place with "Klammlichter" (Gorgeous Lights) and "Sagenhaften Nacht des Wassers" (Legendary Night of the Water) as part of the weekly programme.
- "Zeller Seezauber" (Zell Lake Magic) is a spectacular water, light, music and laser show and a tribute to beautiful Lake Zell. The 20-minute show is staged in Elisabethpark several times a week in the evenings during the summer and fascinates with special effects. Admission is free. In addition to the evening shows, there are great trick fountain displays with music every hour on the hour during the day from 12pm to 6pm.
