The Zell am See-Kaprun Summer Card is your key for great mountain adventures and exciting excursions, for trips to dizzy heights and for relaxing days by the lake. It offers you admission to our premium partners as well as discounts and specials at our bonus partners in the region.

HOW CAN I GET A SUMMER CARD?

You can get the Summer Card from numerous accommodation providers of every category in the region when you book to stay there for at least one night. More information on these partners can be found on our website (www.zellamsee-kaprun.com), in the Zell am See-Kaprun App or in the local tourist information office.

WHEN IS THE SUMMER CARD VALID AND FOR HOW LONG?

Every guest who comes to visit Zell am See-Kaprun between 15.05.–31.10.2023 and stays in a Summer Card partner accommodation will receive a Summer Card, which is valid for the duration of their stay (including day of arrival and departure. Exception: Validity from 15.07.–15.09.).

CAN THE SUMMER CARD BE TRANSFERRED TO ANOTHER PERSON?

No, because it is personalised. All guests (including children) receive their own Summer Card. If you lose the card, a new one will be issued in your name.

CAN I BUY A SUMMER CARD?

The Summer Card cannot be purchased. It is only available from participating accommodation providers.

HOW OFTEN CAN I USE THE SUMMER CARD?

You can make use of the range of benefits and attractions as often as you like during the period in which the Summer Card is valid. **15.07.–15.09.:** valid from 3 pm on the day of arrival. The Schmittenhöhe summit trip via the Schmittenhöhebahn and trassXpress, the Kitzsteinhorn summit trip, round trip on lake Zell, Kaprun High Mountain Reservoirs can be used from the 2nd day of your stay. Exception: The round trip boat tour is limited to a single use within six days. A detailed overview on the special conditions of use can be found on page 51.

CAN THE SUMMER CARD ALSO BE USED AS A PINZGAU MOBILITY CARD?

Yes, you can also use the Summer Card on public transport services. More information on the Mobility Card can be found on page 32.

01 SCHMITTENHÖHE ZELL AM SEE

PANORAMA & FAMILY MOUNTAIN:



The various cable cars on the Schmittenhöhe take you quickly and easily up to the mountain fun with 360° panoramic views.

HIGH ALTITUDE PROMENADE & MYSTICAL FOREST:

The adventure hiking trail and “High Altitude Promenade” between the Schmittenhöhe summit and Sonnkogel has themed boards and viewing platforms. So you can enjoy a diverse mountain experience for the whole family. Afterwards, the adventure hiking trail “Mystical Forest” will take you on an exiting journey through the world of legends. A free shuttle service runs from the Schmiedhofalm to the Sonnenalmbahn mountain station.

SCHMIDOLIN'S BAPTISM OF FIRE:

Apart from experiencing beautiful nature, different stations with tests of courage await young guests – so get your adventure pass and collect the flint stones along the path.

ELECTRIC-MOTOCROSS PARK:



Adventure and driving pleasure with full power. Teens and adults drive the KTM electro-motorcycle while children step on the gas on “OSET bikes” (for a fee).

KITZSTEINHORN KAPRUN

TOP OF SALZBURG

On 3,029 m, the Kitzsteinhorn summit is within arm's reach. Here is Salzburg's highest-situated tourist attraction: TOP OF SALZBURG is open year-round and borders the High Tauern National Park, the Alps' largest nature reserve.



HIGH-ALPINE ADVENTURE WORLD

Standing on eye level with the surrounding 3,000ers on two panoramic platforms, diving in High Tauern's flora and fauna in Salzburg's highest-situated cinema, and getting to know how mountain crystals form, what permafrost is and much more in the 360-m-long tunnel.



ICE ARENA

Sliding on glacier snow and relaxing on the snow beach (approx. early July until late August)



HIKING

Breathtakingly beautiful and varied – the Kitzsteinhorn offers both gentle loop hikes and high-alpine rocky landscape with steep karst trails.

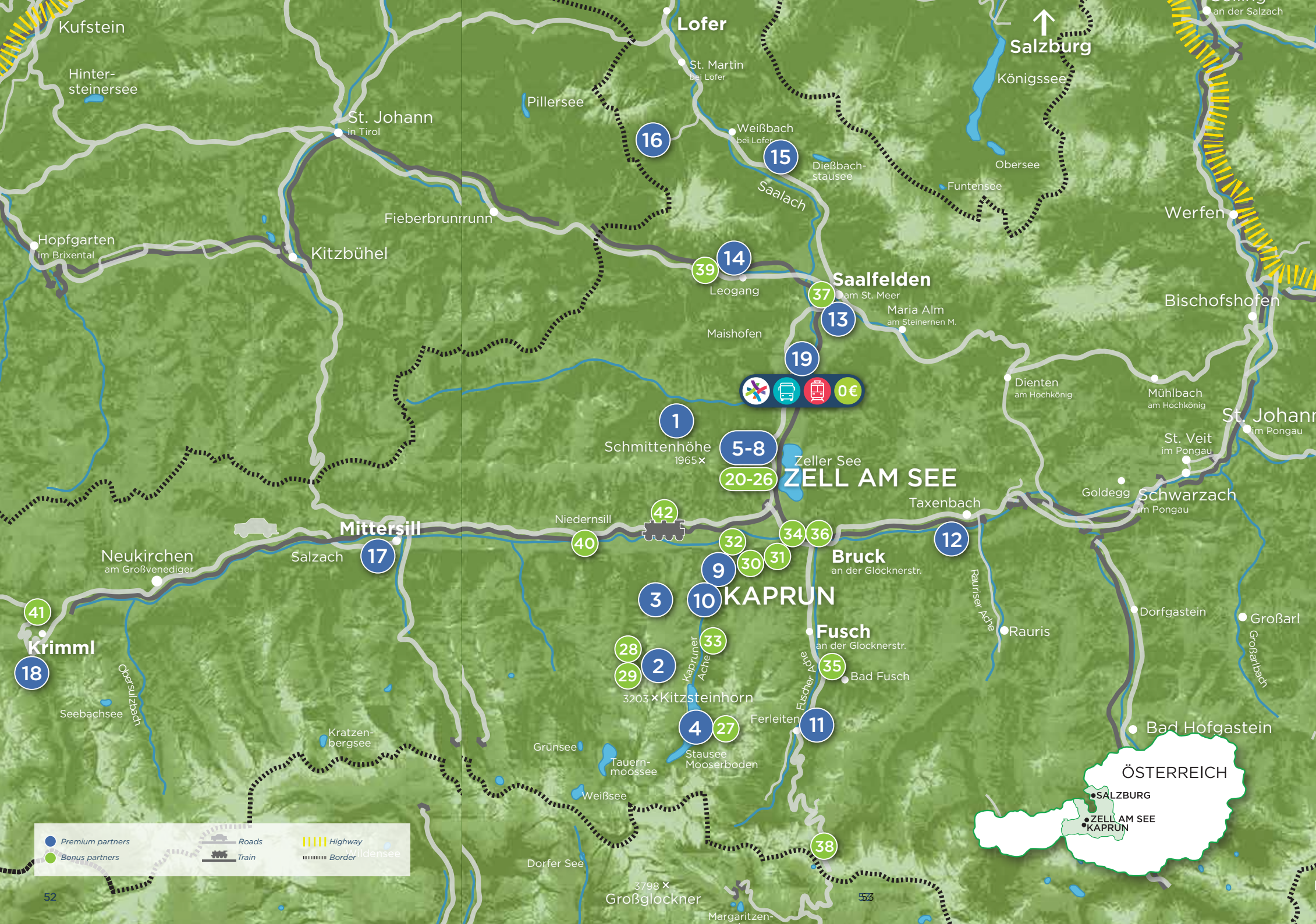

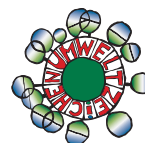
